The morning programme provides the General English language base required for candidates undertaking the FCE and CAE examinations combining study of grammatical, lexical and phonological language systems with skills development appropriate to the examinations as well as to 'real life' needs.

The Cambridge afternoon programmes (FCE & CAE) provide the specialised examination training and practice for the skills and the language competence required by these examinations.

The afternoon programme provides preparation for all 5 papers: Reading, Writing, English in Use, Listening, Speaking including training and practice in:

- Reading & Listening Skills
- Application of Language Systems
- Vocabulary
- Grammar
- Spelling
- Punctuation
- Registered Mail Cohesion and Coherence
- Production of a range of text types
- Spoken Interaction



Accommodation

Accommodation will be with one of our experienced British host families. Staying with a host family gives the opportunity to practise what has been learned during the day and absorb English expressions, which only occur in the home or family. Accommodation will provide a single room with half board during the week and full board at the weekend.
